While she reigned as the football queen during her senior year, she remembers receiving a lot of flowers throughout the year. She attended Mississippi State College for Women and received her degree in Business Administration. After graduation she worked for Union Carbide in Alabama where she met her future husband who was an engineer building a project nearby. They fell in love, married and in 1953 moved to New Jersey. They moved to Pasadena in 1965 and started their own business. They raised three sons; although one is now deceased. Her husband died in 1976 and she sold their business and went to work for Parsons Engineering as a buyer. The company employed 12,600 employees and she became the first female Department Manager of her discipline at Parsons. She had also been named employee of the month for the company. A friend introduced her to duplicate bridge and she became hooked during the mid-seventies. Our lady retired in 1994, lived briefly in the east, then to Albuquerque and moved back to our area in 2002. Her hobbies besides bridge include knitting, needlepoint, and traveling. She has a granddaughter near 10 and a grandson who is five years old, who live far away but she loves to visit them as often as she can.
