Bridge Etiquette

The following points will ensure that partnerships enjoy the game of bridge to the fullest extent possible:

1. Bridge is a social game. It is a game that requires the interaction of all of the participants. Therefore, respect must be always shown for each and every person participating.
 - A. Always respect your partner. Do not criticize your partner for making a wrong play.
 - B. Always respect your opponents. Do not criticize the opponents for making a wrong play.
 - C. Always respect yourself. Do not criticize yourself for making a wrong play.
2. Do not discuss hands at the table. Instead, make notes to be discussed with your partner after the game.
3. Do not discuss hands with opponents at the table. Especially, do not explain to them how they could have defeated a contract. Remember, other tables have ears!
4. Always greet the opponents. However, additional comments, such as how are the grandchildren, etc., should wait until the game is over. Think of it this way: you come to the game with a full tank of energy, which is necessary to play your best game. You don't want to use this energy on minor issues, which might distract from the game at hand.
5. Be attentive at the table. This includes being the dummy. Do not disrupt the table by suggesting you take a smoking break if you are the dummy. This is discourteous to your partner and the table. Of course, if you need to leave the table, inform the director.
6. Compliment the opponents for playing a hand or defending a hand well. Remember, the fact you got a bad result is not necessarily because you played improperly. It is insulting to the opponents to suggest that they lucked out, etc.!
7. Only ask very good players/teachers for bridge advice.
