Weak Two-Bid Convention

Harold Vanderbilt included **Weak Two-Bids** as part of his Vanderbilt Club System, one of the first complete bidding systems. The modern version of this convention was popularized by Howard Schenken.

Advantages of the convention include preempting opponents and a lead directive suit for partner.

Disadvantages include preempting partner, playing contracts from the weak hand, and divulging hand distribution to the opponents.

Requirements:

Bids of two diamonds, two hearts, and two spades reflect a six-card suit and 5-10 high card points (note: 6-10 high card points is also popular).

Suit quality should be disciplined in first and second seat; this means a minimum of two of the top three honors. The exception is one of the top two honors and the jack and ten (i.e. AJ10, KJ10).

Third seat **Weak Two-Bids** can be less disciplined, and can even be done on a good five card suit (i.e. AKQXX, X, XXXX, XXX could be opened two spades).

Fourth seat **Weak Two-Bids** are generally not recommended, unless the suit is spades and also meets the rule of 15 (high card points plus number of spades equals 15).

First and second seat **Weak Two-Bids** deny an outside four card major suit (i.e. player should initially pass with KQJXXX, XXXX, XX, X).

Seven card suits should either be preempted at the three level or passed. Do not preempt a seven card suit at the two level, since partner will not have a proper picture of the hand and possible contract level.

Subsequent bids by the opener and responder:

Most partnerships play *raise only non-forcing* (RONF). This means that any suit bid by responder other than the preempt suit is forcing one round, providing the bid is less than a game bid. The raise of opener's preempt suit is generally used to further preempt the auction (i.e. RONF), realizing that the opponents probably have a better contract.

The bid of 2NT by responder asks opener to bid an outside feature (ace, king). The exception is the response of 3NT by opener which reflects a running suit (i.e. AKQXXX, XX, XXX, XX). Depending upon the answer by opener, responder can better determine whether to play in a part-score, game, or possible slam contract.

Partnerships using non-disciplined **Weak Two-Bids** often use a convention called **Ogust**. The bid of 2NT by responder asks opener to explain suit quality and high card points. This convention is not necessary when playing disciplined **Weak Two-Bids** since the suit quality is already known.

Conclusion:

Weak Two-Bids are an effective bidding tool when used properly.
