Swiss Team Strategies

Bid vulnerable games with a 50% chance of success. The rewards offset the potential downside. Example: if you bid two vulnerable games and one makes and the other goes down one trick, you would still achieve an overall positive result if the other team only bid two part scores:

Board #1: (your pair) $4 \vee \text{ minus one } = -100$ (opponents) 3♥ making = -140**Total Score= Minus 6 IMPs** -240 Board #2: (your pair) 4♥ making = +620(opponents) $3 \checkmark \text{ plus one} = -170$ **Total Score = Plus 10 IMPs**

Net Difference: Plus 4 IMPs

Avoid bidding non-vulnerable games with a 50% chance of success. The rewards do not offset the potential downside.

Board #3:(your pair) $4 \checkmark \text{ minus one} = -50$ (opponents) 3 ♥ making = -140**Total Score = Minus 5 IMPs** -190 Board #4 (your pair) 4♥ making = +420 (opponents) 3 ♥ plus one = - 170 **Total Score = Plus 6 IMPs** +250Net Difference: Plus 1 IMP

Be careful bidding small slams. Grand slams should only be bid if you can absolutely count 13+ tricks before the dummy hits the table!

Do not make speculative doubles (i.e. the auction seemed weird; the opponents stole our contract). The risk is not worth the reward. This is particularly true when doubling part-score contracts. Learn to be more conservative when doubling, even if the opponents steal the bid once in awhile.

Do not make sacrifices which might lead to substantial negative results. Unlike pair events, a major loss on a board can cost the team the whole match, regardless of how many boards were won.

It is better to take a plus score on a board instead of risking going down in a contract which has little chance of success.

Never jeopardize a contract in order to make a possible overtrick. In fact, learn to safety play contracts whenever possible to ensure success, especially concerning games/slams. Overtricks generally do not win matches and have a minimal impact on overall victory points.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

During our recent Board of Directors election cycle, I was very disappointed in the lack of nominees willing to step forward. There were no nominees from Hemet and only 1 from Sun City for 2 seats up for election. In order to make this easier for future nominating committees, I'm recommending to the Board and our membership that the bylaws be changed to cut down the number of board members from 10 to 7.

The Board seats will be apportioned as follows:

Hemet - 2 seats.

Sun City - 2 seats.

Murrieta/Temecula - 2 Seats.

The 7th seat will be filled by the immediate Past President.

The board should function just as well with 7 members as it did with 10 or 11 members in the past.

This proposal will be voted on at the December 12th General Membership Meeting.

I'm also going to recommend to the Board at our November meeting to discontinue the May Temecula Sectional and the August NLM Sectional. The Unit is required to have at least 1 Sectional a year, therefore the annual Sun City Fall Sectional should continue.

The Sectionals have been a lot of work and the volunteers to do this work have diminished in the past several years. The one's that used to do it are getting tired of it and there aren't any new ones stepping forward.

Another reason is that Unit 534 members do 99% of the work and end up with less than 15% of the net receipts.

I'm also going to proposed that the Sunday Swiss lunch be discontinued mainly due to the work required for volunteers to prepare and serve the lunch since we quit using the catered lunch.

Our players are satisfied with the restaurants available in Sun City on Friday and Saturday and there's no reason to think there will any difference on Sunday. We will allow ample time for them to go out for lunch.

Bridge Players seem to do very well at Regionals and Nationals where no lunch is served during the games.

PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGE.

Article V UNIT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

A. <u>Number of Directors</u>—The affairs of the Unit shall be managed and conducted by the Unit Board of Directors which shall consist of nine (9) six (6) persons, plus the immediate past President, all of whom must be members of the Unit.

B. **Proportional Representation**--No Changes

C. <u>Term of Office</u>— Each director shall hold office for a period of two (2) years, the term to coincide with the calendar year and shall continue to hold office until relieved by a duly elected successor. The terms of the Directors shall be staggered to provide for election of four (4) three (3) directors one year, and five (5) three (3) directors the following year.

Note: No Board member shall be removed because of the above changes. When their term expires, the board membership shall revert to the above changes.
