Also Jacoby Transfers, 4NT Blackwood (Std.), Michaels cue bid, Jacoby 2NT, Gerber over NT, Unusual 2NT, Weak 2 & 3 openers. Strong 2 Club Openers (2D response = waiting), Reverses, Grand slam force, 4th-suit xfers,

Texas xfers, DOPI. Other features: Negative doubles thru 2 spades, 8-16 HCP simple overcall, 1 NT opener = 15-17 HCP. 1NT overcall = 15-18 HCP, 2D-2H-2S opener = weak (5-11 HCP).
