Message from the President

Welcome to the ceremony to recognize the master point achievements of our fellow bridge players. Congratulations to all!

As we celebrate these accomplishments, we should also take note of the contributions of our volunteers - too many to name here - whose efforts ensure that we have an opportunity to enjoy our favorite game. Foremost among them is Dennis Boomgaarden – always supported by his better-half Arden - whose leadership, dedication, and hard work over many years have resulted in a well-functioning Unit with good records and proper systems and processes.

Our Unit is in good financial shape. The 2011 financial statements – Statement of Financial Position (balance sheet) and Statement of Activities (income statement) - were audited and approved by the Board. They are posted on our web site: www.acbldistrict22/534. Our terrific webmaster Rick Kerbel also posts the monthly statement of our receipts and disbursement that are prepared by our very competent treasurer Ron Williams. As of the end of January 2012, we have some \$15,000 in the bank and we have no debt.

Our main challenge is the decline in our membership. As of March 1, 2012, we had 217 members. In terms of master points, 91 have 0-50, 56 have 51-200, and the remaining 70 have 200 or more master points. In terms of ACBL rank, we have 129 non-life masters, 5 life masters, 31 bronze life masters, 42 silver life masters, 9 gold life masters, and one solitary diamond life master – way to go Jim Wooden. We have no emerald, platinum, or grand life masters; YET!

Our current membership number is down from the peak of 362 in 2005 (a drop of 40%). Part of the reason for this is our ageing population although there are other important factors. Our average age as of the end of 2011 was 76 years old, which compares with 70 years for the entire ACBL membership. Incidentally, our female representation is 59% which is in line with the 62% for ACBL.

To make sure that we make the joy of the game available to as many people as possible and maintain a vibrant environment, we need to re-double of our recruiting efforts and at the same time improve services. Your Board has collected a number of suggestions, through conversations with the membership and by looking at the experiences of other ACBL units, with regards to both of these matters. We will try to implements a number of these initiatives over the next two years with particular emphasis on supporting new players.

The success of these efforts is entirely dependent on the willingness of our members to give a helping hand. So, while I am cognizant of the need not to burden anyone unduly, please do accept to volunteer when asked.
